



Gerald Raymond Scofield II

Gerald "Jerry" Raymond Scofield II, long-time resident of Boulder, Colorado, died of natural causes on Saturday, September 14, 2013 at Mission Hospital in Mission Viejo, California. Jerry was born June 2, 1945 in Denver, CO and was raised in Boulder by his parents June Rose and Gerald Raymond Scofield Sr. Jerry graduated from Boulder High in 1963 where he played basketball and participated in track and field.
